Financial and Social Impact

In 2020:

- 145 business training events held for 2,141 attendees
- Over 700 individuals received more than 1,400 hours of one-on-one business counseling
- Over \$52 million in small grants provided to over 4,800 small businesses through Fairfax County's RISE program administered by CBP
- Over \$2.2 million provided to businesses affected by the COVID-19 through Fairfax County's microloan program developed by CBP
- Those served by CBP include:
 - 65% People of Color
 - 66% Female
 - 34% Male
 - 12% Veterans
 - 6% Service Disabled Veterans
 - 7% Disabled
